A Funeral Liturgy for Margaret Dean "Deanie" Healy, of Easton, will be celebrated at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Easton, on Tuesday, August 28, 2001 at 10:00 AM.

Mrs. Healy died at the Talbot Hospice House on Friday, August 24, 2001. She was 71.

Born in Havre de Grace, MD, July 17, 1930, she attended public school in Baltimore where she lived until moving to the Eastern Shore in 1957. She worked at the Chesapeake Bowling Lanes Snack Bar in Easton with her mother from 1965 until 1975. She then worked for Drs. Fitzgerald, Devine and Knud-Hansen as a secretary/receptionist from 1975 until retiring in 1994.

A member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, she bowled with the Wednesday morning league. An avid Orioles fan, she was devoted to her family.

Mrs. Healy is survived by three daughters, Donna Brewer Clem of Oxford, Barbara Hope and Paula Broll, both of Easton; a son, Thomas "Mooch" Healy, of Easton; five grandchildren, Joseph Hope, Michael Endzel, Jennifer Hope, Kristen Endzel Berezney and Conor Broll and two great-grandchildren, Mitchell Berezney and Thomas Alls. Her mother, Jessie M. Cahall, died in

March of 1995.
