Margaret E. Roe, of Easton, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Wednesday, September 3, 2003. She was 89.

Born in Easton, April 21, 1914, she was the daughter of the late John and Susan Elizabeth Blann Marsh. After graduating from Easton High School, she, in 1935, married C. Wilson Roe. They made their home briefly in Easton before moving to Havre de Grace, then Puerto Rico and back to Havre de Grace before returning to Easton in 1947. Here she assisted her husband in the ownership and operation of a fleet of dump trucks and later in the operation of a service station on Route 50 known as Roe's Service Station. After Mr. Roe's retirement in 1976, she remained active in the business until its sale in the 1980's.

A longtime member of the Knights of Pythias, her hobbies included needlepoint, cross stitch and crocheting and playing bingo.

Mr. Roe died August 23, 1982.

Mrs. Roe is survived by two sons, John Carroll Roe and his wife, Peggy, and J. Robert Roe and his wife, Sylvia, all of Easton; a sister, Joyce M. Roszak of Havre de Grace; five grandchildren, Karen Scott and her husband, Chris, Michael Roe, Chris Roe, Beth Roe and Becky Greene and her husband,

James and seven great-grandchildren. A sister, Betty Thomas and two brothers, John Lewis Marsh and Elbert Marsh, are deceased.
