



## Margaret E. Roe

August 28, 1925 - January 9, 2011

Margaret Elizabeth Roe of Easton died on Sunday, January 9, 2011 at the Talbot Hospice House. She was 85.

Born in Wittman on August 28, 1925, she was the daughter of the late, George L. and Ethel McQuay Jackson. She attended St. Michaels High School. On August 1, 1942, she married James W. Roe.
