Margaret E. "Peg" David of Easton died at Genesis Eldercare-the Pines, Easton, on Saturday January 10, 2004. She was 97.

Born in Baltimore on July 16, 1906 she was the daughter of the late John T. and Theresa Hoff Gorsuch. After graduating Eastern High School in Baltimore in 1923, she worked as a secretary, then on July 10, 1927, married Alphonse S. "Doc" David. They moved to Easton in 1938 where he died in April 1994.

Mrs. David was very active in the community, holding offices at many local and county levels to include the Talbot Co. P.T.A., Girl Scouts of America, leader for the Girls 4H Club, Red Cross Chairperson, Women's Civil Defense during WWII, the Talbot Homemaker's Club and a volunteer for the American Cancer Society. Her hobbies include gardening, sewing needlework, Arts and crafts.

A member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church of Easton where she served as Sunday school and Vacation Bible School teacher, she also was a member of the choir and Altar Guild, Lutheran Women's Missionary league, both locally and on a District level and was a member of the building committee for the planning of the present church building.

Mrs. David is survived by a son; Stephen T. "Perky" David of Evansville, IN; a

daughter, Margaret A. "Peggy" Reeder of Keshena, WI; 5 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. A daughter, Johanna E. Samuels died in January of 1997 and a son, Richard S. David died in August of 1993.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday January 14th, at 11 A. M. at The Immanuel Lutheran Church, Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Private burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton.
