Margaret G. Collins, of Easton, MD died at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton, on Wednesday, July 14, 2004. She was 89.

Born in Cordova, MD, January 17, 1915, she was the daughter of the late John Wesley and Naomi G. Sedgwick Dawson. After attending public school, she married George Elmer Collins, a truck driver and later farmer, on Dec. 2, 1931. They made their home in Caroline County briefly before moving to a farm near Cordova which she helped him operate. After his death in May of 1974, she continued the operation of the farm until 2001 when she retired for health reasons.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton, she was a past member of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Cordova Vol. Fire Company. Devoted to her family, she enjoyed crocheting and sewing items which she frequently entered in local fairs. Her other interests included gardening and canning.

Mrs. Collins is survived by three daughters, Charlotte J. Blades and Linda A. Faulkner, both of Cordova and Rev. Joan C. Wolff of Easton; two sons, Edward F. Collins, Sr. and Ray E. Collins, both of Cordova ; a sister, Marie B. Ostergaard of Sartell, MN; seven grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren and one great-great granddaughter. Two infant children, Elmira E. and David Collins, and three brothers, Harry E. Dawson, J. Otis Dawson and Lawrence

Dawson, are deceased.
