Margaret Heckert Dickson of Easton, MD died Sunday June 23, 2002 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 96.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA November 13, 1905, she was the daughter of, prominent architect and civic leader, Sidney Frederick Heckert and Margaret Malone Heckert. After graduating from Carnegie Mellon she attended the Sorbonne, Paris France. In 1932 she married pioneer aviator, George Edwards Dickson, also of Pittsburgh. In 1947 she moved to Talbot County. During the early 1950's through 1960 Mrs. Dickson, along with the late Mrs. George Wallace of Trappe, pioneered music therapy at the Eastern Shore State Mental Hospitals at Cambridge and Crownsville.

Mr. Dickson died at his home at St. Simons Island, GA in 1961.

Her memberships included the Talbot County Garden Club, Academy of the Arts and the Harbor Club. She was a charter member and board member of the Talbot County Historical Society and a charter member of the Eastern Shore Doll Study Club.

Mrs. Dickson is survived by, a daughter, Margaret D. Portman of NC; a son, Sidney H. Dickson of St. Michaels, MD; two grandchildren, James I. Pearce III, of NC and Eliza E. Dickson of Miami Beach, FL; one step-grandson,

Rodney Spring; one great granddaughter, Kristen D. Pearce of NC; and one niece Margaret F. Terry of NC. She was predeceased by a son, George Jr., who was lost at sea with his new bride, Peggy Newbaker Dickson in 1960. Her twin sister, Frances Heckert Fisher, Jr. of Easton died in 1998.

A memorial service will be held in November.

Interment will be private.

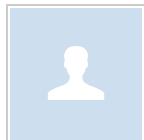
