Margaret M. "Peg" Alcorn of Tilghman, passed away at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, on Saturday, February 9, 2002. She was 71.

Born in Laurel, Maryland, on October 16, 1930, she was the daughter of P.G. Melbourne II and Bernice Grady Melbourne.

Graduated from Laurel High School, in Laurel, Maryland, graduated from Southern Seminary, Buena Vista, Virginia and taught Pre-kindergarten at the Town and Country School, Wheaton, Maryland. While with Town and Country School, she managed a branch of the school and published a paper on teaching reading to pre-kindergarten children. She was also the owner of two Arts and Crafts stores and a children's consignment store.
