Margaret Roberta “Robbie” Waller Griffin died on Sunday, March 12, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton.

Born in Washington D.C. on February 17, 1931 she was the daughter of the late John R. and Margaret T. Waller. Mrs. Griffin graduated from the Madeira School in 1948 and Connecticut College in 1952 and was commissioned in Naval Service from 1953-1959. She married James Donald Griffin, Jr. on August 9, 1958. They shared their life in Bethesda and Easton Maryland. Mr. Griffin died in 1987.

Committed to volunteering in every aspect of her community, in Washington she was a sustaining member of the Junior League, Chairman of the first docent program at the Folger Shakespeare Library, President of the Ladies Board of the House of Mercy and her other volunteer activities included the Recording for the Blind and Meals on Wheels. She was a member of the Chevy Chase Club and the Sulgrave Club. She moved to Oxford in 1988 and volunteered at the Oxford Library, Oxford Museum, Academy Art Museum, The Historical Society, and The Waterfowl Festival. She was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club and a sectional master of the American Contract Bridge League. Robbie had a generous spirit, loved her friends, family, travel and life.

Survivors include a son, Lt. Col. James Donald Griffin III, USMC, of New Bern,

North Carolina and his wife Kristi, a daughter Margaret Griffin Begor and her husband Rob of Oxford, and daughter Mary Leslie Griffin of Silver Spring; grandchildren Austin Waller Griffin, Caroline Stuart Griffin and John Daniel Griffin; Annie and Jamie Labat and step-grandchildren Katherine and Jacob Begor.

A memorial service will be held at Christ Church, Easton, where she was a member, on Saturday, March 18th, at 11:00 a.m.

Inurnment will be conducted at a later date.
