Margaret S. Nash of Queenstown, MD died on Tuesday, November 23, 2010 at Easton Memorial Hospital. She was 78.

Margaret S. Nash was born on February 10, 1932 in Easton, MD to the late, James R. Seward and Margaret Jump Seward. She attended Centreville High School, graduating class of 1949. She then graduated from Milford Memorial Hospital in 1951, receiving her Registered Nursing Degree. On December 20, 1952, she married Robert E. Nash, III and they resided in Chester, MD, and later to Queenstown, MD. In 1954, Mrs. Nash began working at Easton Hospital, where she became head nurse of the recovery room. In 1961, she came home to raise her family, until 1973, when she began at Caroline Nursing Home. She later worked at the Dixon House in 1980, Corsica Hills, and later retired from the Renal Treatment Center in 1997 after 8 years.

Mrs. Nash was a member of the Bay Country Moose Lodge ~ Ladies Auxiliary and the Calvary United Methodist Church. She enjoyed genealogy and spending time with her family.
