



## Margaret Willis Stevens

Margaret Willis Stevens of Easton, formerly of Trappe, MD, died on Wednesday, April 13, 2005 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines. She was 97.

Born May 24, 1907 at "Clora Dorsey" in Island Creek Neck, Trappe, MD, she was the daughter of the late Charles Francis and Laura Woodland Ross Willis. She was a 1923 graduate of Easton High School. In December of 1934 she married Edward Perry Stevens, a Trappe district farmer, and they made their home at "Beechwood" near Trappe. Mr. Stevens died in 1948.

In 1953 she moved into Trappe where she worked at home doing mending and alterations. She quilted and made many comforters. A yearly project for many years, she did the quilting for the annual quilt raffle for St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Trappe. In 2000 she went to live at Dixon House in Easton.

A lifetime member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, she taught Sunday School and was active in the women's group for many years.

Mrs. Stevens is survived by her daughter, Ann B. Stevens of Preston; a sister, Laura W. Covington of Easton; a grandson, Michael E. Henry, and his wife Margaret of Hurlock; a granddaughter, Carole A. Keyser and her husband Larry of Trappe; four great-grandchildren, Christopher and Whitney Henry of Hurlock and Cody and Allen Keyser of Trappe; three step grandchildren,

Jenny Lane, Amy Lord and Kim Henry; four step great-grandchildren; and her former son-in-law, Ira E. "Eddie" Henry of Easton. She was predeceased by a brother, Charles F. Willis, Jr. who died in 1980, and a step-grandson, Robert "Rock" Henry.

Graveside services will be held on Monday, April 18, 2005 at 11:00 AM at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
