



## Margaruite F. Comegys

November 11, 1924 - August 31, 2015

Margaruite “Sis” Frances Comegys of Annapolis, MD, died August 31, 2015, at Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville, MD. She was 90 years old.

Born in Annapolis on November 11, 1924, she was the daughter of the late Bernard A. and Gertrude King Kelly.

Mrs. Comegys is survived by her daughter, Darby Cissel and her husband, Chester of Centreville, MD; grandchildren, Shannon Makovsky and her husband, Glenn, Gregory Cissel and his wife, Jodi, and Julie Pfeiffer and her husband, Kevin; and great-grandchildren, Cody, Caitlin, and Brett Pfeiffer and Cooper and Quinn Makovsky; sisters, Bootsie Wojnarowski and Katsie Daywalt; brother, Jake Kelly; sister in-law, Babe Kelly; brother in-law, John Comegys; and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her first husband, William A. Hitt; second husband, William Comegys; and brother, Bernard Kelly.

Mrs. Comegys graduated from Annapolis High School in 1941. She worked for the U.S. Coast Guard Magazine from 1943-1949. In 1986, Margaruite retired after 31 years of state service with the Income Tax Division of the Maryland Comptroller of the Treasury. In the 1960's, she was active with the Queenstown Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary. Margaruite was also a Ladies Auxiliary Volunteer for the Anne Arundel Medical Center for many years.

Mrs. Comegys loved to reminisce about her childhood days growing up in Eastport, MD. She crabbed and fished in the creeks and the Bay around Eastport and Annapolis with her father and older brother. She also had fond memories of family picnics on her grandfather's two-masted schooner, the "Smith K. Martin." In 1899, this schooner was made for her grandfather, Levin Pertiman Kelly, "Capt. Pert," in Pocomoke City, MD.
