Annapolis – Margot Foose Eliason, 75, formerly of Chestertown, died on October 24, 2006 at her home in Annapolis.

Born in South Orange, NJ, on October 31, 1930, she was the daughter of the late Robert Paul Foose and Grace Althoff Foose.

After graduation from Columbia High School in South Orange, she attended Greenbriar College. In 1977, she received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Psychology from Washington College.

She worked for the J. B. Lippincott Co. in Philadelphia as a medical illustrator before moving to Chestertown in 1954 to be married.

Mrs. Eliason had two sons, was a member of Emmanuel Church and worked as a landscape artist. After moving to Annapolis in the 1980's, she worked for the Annapolis Housing Authority, while continuing her interests in painting and writing.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by a son John C. "Skeeter" Eliason, Jr. in 2004. She is survived by one son Robert G. "Bobby" Eliason of Charlottesville, VA; two grandchildren: Eben Eliason of Lancaster, PA and Addie Eliason Pepoli of Fitchburg, MA; and one brother: Robert William Foose of Port Washington, NY.
