Marguerite T. Crew of Chestertown, MD died on Monday, August 1, 2005, in Chester River Hospital Center, Chestertown, MD. She was 91.

Born May 1, 1914, in Kent County, Maryland, she was the daughter of the late, Aaron and Margaret Whitlock Taylor. She was educated in Kent County. Mrs. Crew and her husband operated the Crew Farm in Langford and in 1951 they purchased Rose Hill Farm which they operated until 1981. As a farmer's wife, she worked on the farm and raised seven children.

She enjoyed sewing, crocheting, crossword puzzles and reading. She was an active participant with Chestertown Physical Therapy at Chester River Hospital Center. She was a member of St. James United Methodist Church and the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post 36, Ladies Auxiliary in Chestertown, MD.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death in September 2001 by her husband, Marion Crew, whom she married in 1932, and a son, David Crew, who died in 1985.
