Marguerite Ellen Guernsey was born in Poughkeepsie, NY on April 22, 1954 to the late, H.W. Guernsey and Mary Jane (Baum) Guernsey.

She attended private school at Emma Willard School in Troy, NY, graduating in 1972, before completing her bachelor's degree in 1976 from Boston University. Miss Guernsey resided in Dutchess County, NY working as a bookkeeper at Star Quality until 1994. That year, she moved to Annapolis, MD and continued her occupation as a bookkeeper with the Eastport Yacht Club. In 1998, she moved to Easton, MD and began a freelancing bookkeeping business working for many companies in Talbot County.

Miss Guernsey was an avid outdoorsman, where she enjoyed bird watching. She has conducted research for Cornell Laboratory of Ornithology, U.S. Fish and Wildlife, and Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge. She was a member of the Talbot County Bird Club.

Miss Guernsey is survived by three brothers, Homer W. Guernsey, of Clinton Corners, NY, John Guernsey, of Santa Fe, NM, and David Guernsey, of Pine Plains, NY.
