



## Marguerite M. Thomas

October 9, 1912 - March 8, 2013

Marguerite Marshall Thomas of Felton, DE. and formerly of Centreville, MD, died on March 8, 2013. She was 100 years old.

Born in Dorchester County on October 9, 1912, she was the daughter of Bernard and Cora D. Marshall. Educated in Talbot County Schools, she was a graduate of Easton High School Class of 1930. She worked in the district office of the Eastern Shore Public Service Co. in Easton, MD.

She married William T. Thomas of Centreville in 1935. Upon moving to Centreville, she worked a few years in the County Agent's office. Later she worked for over 20 years as the secretary of St. Paul's Parish. In 1957, she joined the office staff of Gunston School, later becoming business manager until her retirement in 1992.

Mrs. Thomas was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church and served as Registrar, Treasurer, and on the vestry committee. She was a member of the Gunston School Board of Trustees and served as Treasurer and remained Trustee Emeritus. She was also a member of Corsica River Yacht Club.

William T. Thomas, Sr., passed away in 2004. She is survived by two sons, Richard M. Thomas and his wife Nikki of Leesburg VA, and Timothy C. Thomas and his wife Linda of Felton DE; one son, William T. Thomas, Jr.,

passed away in 1981. She is also survived by five grandchildren, Trisha S. Thomas Chadwick of Annapolis, Reid C. Henry of Centreville, Melissa A. Hood of Glen Burnie, Darrick L. Rosenberry of Denton, Robert B. Young of Alexandria VA; and seven great-grandchildren, Hunter Mansfield, Natalie Henry, Jackson Carty, Guinevere Hood, Clarissa, Charlotte, and Phillip Rosenberry.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, April 13, 2013, at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Centreville.
