



## Maria Ernestine Bitter

July 17, 1927 - November 29, 2012

Maria Ernestine Bitter (Henczi) of Chestertown, MD, died on Thursday, November 29, 2012, at Chester River Manor. She was 85.

She was born in Kikinda Yugoslavia, on July 17, 1927, the daughter of the late Rosa Maria and Alois Henczi. She was schooled in Yugoslavia and Germany. During World War II, she was displaced in several cities in Germany and at times in Czechoslovakia. After the war ended, she settled in Austria and worked as a housekeeper.

While living in Austria, she met her Russian husband, Heinrich Bitter (deceased) where they made their home. In 1953, Mrs. Bitter, her husband and child immigrated to the United States, making their home in Galena. While there, they lived and worked for Dudley Chance, Howard Strong, Jr., and Starkey Farms. In 1962, the family moved to Chestertown.

Mrs. Bitter worked for the local hosiery mill operated by the Fischer family, housecleaned private homes and eventually was employed by the Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in the housekeeping department. In 1979, Mrs. Bitter, her husband, and her eldest son, became citizens of the United States.

She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church and the Women's Guild. Mrs. Bitter's passion was baking German cookies, cakes, and more. Over the

years, family friends and acquaintances had the pleasure of enjoying these treats. She also enjoyed embroidery as she made many pieces for family and friends.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Heinrich Bitter, and a first born son, in Austria. She is survived by three sons, Rudolf Bitter and wife Karen of Chestertown, and Henry Bitter and wife Debbie of Centreville, Hans Bitter and wife Cathy of Worton, MD; one daughter; Rosa Klingenberg and husband Dennis of Snow Hill, MD; seven grandsons, Justin Bitter, Jason Bitter, Brandon Bitter, Daniel Bitter, Nicholas Bitter, Travis Bitter, Ryan Bitter; one granddaughter; Claire Klingenberg; four great- granddaughters; and one great-grandson.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, December 1, 2012, at 11 a.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church where relatives and friends may call one hour prior (10 -11 a.m.).

Interment will be in Chester Cemetery following the service.
