April 17, 1931 - June 14, 2020

Marian T. Wood, 89, of Easton, MD, died peacefully at home on Sunday, June 14, 2020, with her girls by her side.

She was the daughter of the late Charles G. Travers, Jr., and Lone Creighton Travers of Fishing Creek, MD. Mom was born on April 17, 1931 in Fishing Creek, and upon completing high school, she entered the McQueen Gibbs School of Nursing where she graduated and started her nursing career in 1951.
