January 19, 1933 - November 13, 2009

Marian Elizabeth Harris Krausz of Centreville, MD died on Friday, November 13, 2009 at William Hill Manor, Easton, MD. She was 76.

Born January 19, 1933 in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Marion Wilson and Frances Brown Lovejoy Harris. She grew up in Centreville and graduated from Centreville High School, Class of 1949, she then attended Southern Seminary Junior College in Buena Vista, VA and the University of Maryland where she received her BA Degree. On September 11, 1954 she married Francis Donald Krausz of Baltimore, MD and they made their home in the Annapolis area until 1983 when she returned to Centreville, MD. Mr. Krausz died on April 8, 1988.
