



## Marian Peabody Everdell

December 7, 1981 - June 2, 2010

Marian Peabody Everdell died on June 2, 2010. She was 28.

Born December 7, 1981 in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of Preston and Sarah Jayne Everdell of Centreville, MD. She grew up on the campus of Gunston Day School in Centreville, MD where her parents are teachers, as well as in Sedgwick, Maine. Molly, as she was known, graduated from Kent School in Chestertown, MD, St. George's School in Newport, Rhode Island and attended Washington College, Chesapeake College and College of the Atlantic.

An artist and poet as well as a great sailor, Molly will be remembered for her creativity, and her adventurous and passionate spirit. She was a vivacious, energetic, and charming young woman who, in the end, lost her battle with serious mental illness.

In addition to her parents, she is survived by her brother, Nicholas P. Everdell and his wife, Keara Shea Everdell of New York City. She is also survived by her grandfather, three aunts and uncles, and seven cousins.
