Marie Usilton Dulin peacefully went to be with her Lord on March 24, 2021. Born in Price, Maryland, to Lewis and Peachie Usilton, she was preceded in death by her sister, Violet, and her two brothers, Harold and Grant. She married Omer G. Dulin Jr. on January 10, 1942 and spent 70 years by his side until his death in 2012.

Being the oldest child, Marie learned to “take care of others” early in life and that core value never changed. She was a hard worker and a partner to Omer in farming the land, milking the cows, and preparing huge and delicious meals. No one can quite duplicate her fried chicken or macaroni and cheese. Together, they lived a life on the land and their family farm remains a part of the Dulin family.

At age 8, a friend took her to Wye Mills Methodist Church where her Sunday School teacher happened to be Omer’s mother. Marie remained devoted to this church her entire life. She attended her last service in March 2020 prior to the COVID shutdown. She loved that church and held almost every position possible including teaching the pre-school Sunday School class for 50 years and coordinating countless dinners served there. She helped raise ministers’ children and every minister serving during her lifetime enjoyed delicious meals at her home. She loved Bible study and was a true example of what it means to “walk the walk.”

Along with Wye Mills Church, she was devoted to her family. She is survived by sons J.C. Dulin, Dan Dulin (Mary Anne Rogers), and daughter, June VanTilburg. She had a definite hand in helping to raise her grandchildren, Stacy Dulin (Shelly) of Oxford, Md., Nick VanBuskirk (Joyce Brew) of Seattle, WA, Tina Lucarelli (Nick) of Westlake, OH, Doug Dulin (Cheryl) of Bradenton, FL, Tillie Metz of Preston, MD and Jeremy Dulin (Jennie) of Annapolis, MD. 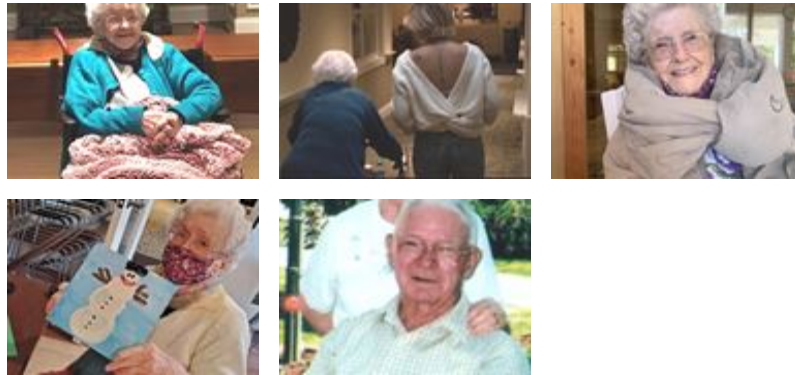

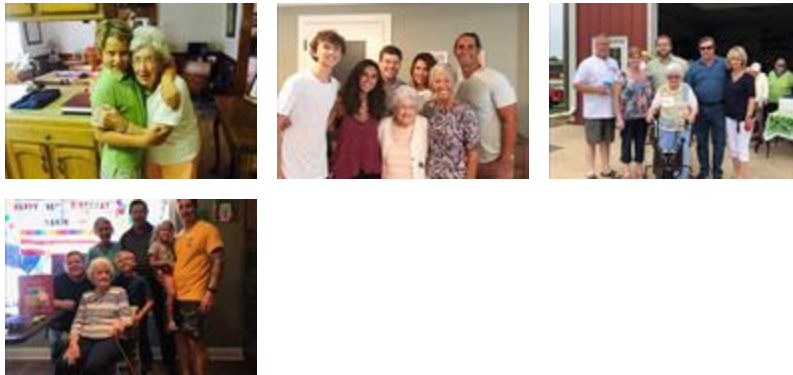

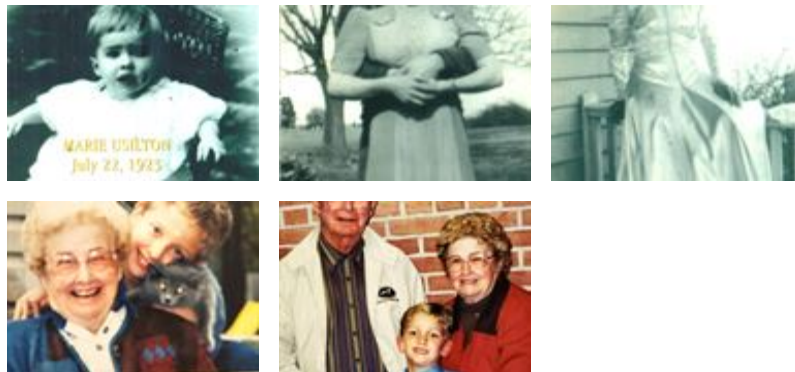
