Marie Magdalena Gruber of Chestertown, MD, died on Monday, November 19, 2012, at Chester River Hospital Center. She was 83.

Born on February 16, 1929, in Philadelphia, PA, she was the daughter of the late Harry Francis and Magdalena Cecilia Horning Gerety. Mrs. Gruber attended Little Flower Catholic High School for Girls, graduating in 1947. After graduation, she trained and worked as a legal secretary for the United States Navy and a private insurance firm in Philadelphia. On October 14, 1950, she married Henry Gordon Gruber. They started their family in 1952 and the following year moved to Chestertown.

Mrs. Gruber was a member of Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church where she was a CCD teacher and Eucharistic Minister. She also belonged to the American Legion Auxiliary, the Red Hat Society, and was a Nearly New volunteer. She loved playing bridge, crocheting, knitting, and painting. Mrs. Gruber collected Hummels and ran two different collectibles stores. Mrs. Gruber was a licensed Realtor and, for over 30 years, along with her husband, owned and operated many real estate development projects.

In addition to her husband, Marie is survived by two daughters, Janice Haney and husband, Charles of Wilmington, DE, and Margaret Young and husband, Brian of Orwigsburg, PA; four sons, Philip Gruber and wife, Donna of

Timonium, MD, James Gruber and wife, Patricia of Chestertown, MD, Raymond Gruber and partner, Sung-Li of Shanghai, China, Henry W.
