Marie Louise Guillou, 88, died on April 24, 2001, at Memorial Hospital in Easton of congestive heart failure.

Born on July 28, 1912, she was the sixth of the offspring of Jean Louis Guillou and Marie Jeanne Bourhis, in Kerzellec, Morbihan, France. She completed four years of school before going to work for her parents on their rural farm. She emigrated to the United States in 1930, working as a domestic helper in the New York City area. She met her future husband, Charles Loring Harrison, an out-of-work electrician, who was delivering groceries to the millionaire summer home at Holly Beach Farm. She married on July 1, 1939, remaining in the Annapolis area for the next 62 years. For many years, she assisted her husband in running Harrison & Palmer, Inc., an electrical contracting firm in Annapolis.

Marie Louise Harrison is survived by two sons, Rev. John B. Harrison, C.Ss.R., of Seaford, DE, and James R. Harrison of Annapolis; a surviving sister, Marie Donars, 92, of Roudouallec, France; three sisters-in-law, Eileen Clausey of Annapolis, Doris Sternberg of Virginia Beach, and Lucille Howard of Florida. Her husband of 42 years, Charles Loring Harrison, died in 1981. A sister-in-law, Helen Ross died this week of 2001.

She and her husband moved to Grasonville in 1964. She belonged to St.

Christopher's Catholic Church, Chester, where she actively participated in various organizations for many years. She also belonged to the Catholic Daughters of the Americas, Court Annapolis. She was a long-time member of the Kent Island Yacht Club, and helped her husband, who was Commodore in 1976. She also actively participated in the Kent Island Federation of Arts. She kept in contact with her many friends via the telephone. She loved to paint using water colors and acrylics. She also enjoyed doing cross-stitching and needle-point.

A Mass will be held 10:00 AM on Saturday, April 28, at St. Christopher's Catholic Church, Chester.
