



Marilyn "Lynn" Virginia Mann

October 13, 1943 - January 17, 2025

Lynn passed away peacefully at her home in Chester, MD, sister and daughter at her bedside, with her favorite view following a longstanding battle with Congestive Heart Failure. She had also fought ferociously with Charcot-Marie-Tooth Disease (CMT) for most of her life. Lynn was a God-loving and gracious grandmother, mother, daughter, sister, niece and cousin who brought peace and joy to all she met. The daughter of Henry and Marilyn Mann (Goetzel), Lynn is survived by her sister Janet Mann, daughter Kallie (Carroll) Mann and her wife Heather, grandchildren Alexandra and Henry Hochberg, uncle Alan Goetzel and his wife Evonne, cousins Greg Goetzel and his wife Kelly, Kelsey Wilson and her husband Jacin, Amanda Goetzel and her fiancée Nick Groff and Marguerite Pilcher.

Lynn had been a teacher for several years following her graduation from Frostburg State Teachers College (now Frostburg State University). She then began her long career with the Maryland Department of Public Safety and Corrections. After retirement from there, Lynn worked a few years, part-time, for the Public Defender's Office in Cambridge, Maryland.

Lynn was a member of Kent Island Methodist Church. Over the course of her life, she volunteered at various hospitals, churches and the local chapter of the CMT Research Foundation.

When she was able, Lynn loved to travel and had been on a cruise or two, traveled to the Holy Lands, Canada, Florida and Arizona. She had made several trips as well to New Hampshire to spend time with her daughter and the kids.

After her working days, Lynn loved spending time with family and friends, making cards with Janet and their friends, and sitting by her bedroom patio doors, watching all the wildlife they were blessed to have in their backyard on the water.

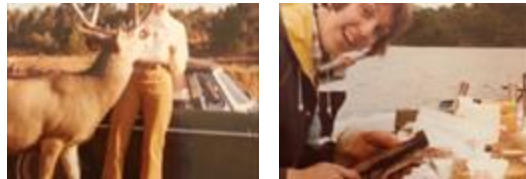
