



## Marilyn B Simpkins

November 22, 1928 - July 2, 2013

Marilyn B. Simpkins, age 84, of Heron Point in Chestertown, MD, died on Tuesday, July 2, 2013, at Heron Point. She was the daughter of the late Wallace E. and Mary Ellen Fitzgibbons Brown.

She is survived by her husband of 61 years, Roger W. Simpkins; a son, Roger W. Simpkins, Jr. (Deborah), of Murrell's Inlet, SC, a daughter, Sarah Cralle (John), of Wilmington, NC; two grandchildren, Tyler Cralle and Sydney Caperlengo; a step-grandson, Seth Holek;, and a great-granddaughter, Kayla. Also surviving is her sister-in-law, Margaret Ann Larsen of Princess Anne, MD; and nephews, Tom and Bill Larsen. Her daughter, Mary Ellen Simpkins, predeceased her.

Born in Fairfield, CT, she graduated from Huntington High School and attended Marshall University in Huntington, WV. In 1951, she married Roger W. Simpkins. They moved to Chestertown in 1955 and resided in Country Club Estates until 1990 when they moved to Savannah, GA. In 1995, the Simpkins returned to Chestertown and moved to Heron Point in 2007.

Marilyn was an active member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church where she served on the altar guild, sang in the choir, and, at one time, coached the girls Church league basketball team. She enjoyed sports, and in high school played varsity basketball and softball. Later she played golf. Cooking,

entertaining, and playing bridge were her passions. Also, over the years she loved caring for her many animals, including her present dogs, Mickey and Minnie.

A memorial service will be held at 3 p.m. on Saturday, July 13, 2013, at the Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Chestertown, MD. A private interment service will be held at St. Paul's Cemetery.
