



Mario Vincent Rossi Sr.

October 18, 1928 - July 23, 2025

Mario (“Vince”) Vincent Rossi, Sr. of Queenstown, MD passed away at Shore Medical Center in Chestertown, MD, on July 23rd, 2025. He was 96.

He was born on October 18, 1928, in Bridgeport, CT, beloved son to the late Vincent and Mildred (nee Barone) Rossi, and loving husband to the late Mary Angela Rossi. He is survived by his daughter, Mary Therese Rossi of Queenstown, MD; half-brother, Alex Mastrocola of Daytona, FL; 3 grandchildren: Mario Vincent Rossi, III. of Tempe, AZ, Michelle Brouillett of SC, and Jennifer Brobinak of Battle Creek, MI; and 2 great-grandchildren: Samantha Rossi and Alisha Rossi, both from AZ. In addition to Mario’s parents and wife, he is preceded in death by his daughter, Mary Angela; son, Mario Vincent, Jr., and his half-sister, Mildren Rosnato.

Mario attended Baltimore Polytechnical Institute in Baltimore, MD. He served in the U.S Navy for 2 years. Mr. Rossi worked as an auto and truck mechanic. In 1949 he went to work for the U.S Coast Guard in Curtis Bay and later he transferred to Naval Research Lab in the Naval Academy where he worked on and off until he retired in 1992. On March 6, 1947 he married the former, Mary Angela Kirby of Baltimore, MD. They lived in the Curtis Bay area for one year, Pasadena, Catonsville, and in December 1995 they moved to Queenstown, MD.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus of St. Christopher's and the American Legion Post #278, Stevensville, MD and St. Christopher's Catholic Church, Stevensville, MD.
