A Funeral Liturgy for Marian G. "Peg" Hoyt, formerly of Easton, will be celebrated at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, Easton, MD on Monday, March 11, 2002 at 12:00 noon. She died on Wednesday, March 6, 2002 at Mallard Bay Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Cambridge, MD. She was 70.

Born October 6, 1931 in Baltimore, MD she was the daughter of the late Frank J. Weber, Jr. and Marion Ellison Weber. She attended Catholic elementary school and then public high school in the Dundalk area of Baltimore. In 1950 she married Leonard Hoyt and they made their home in various places while he served in the United States Military. In the early 1960's they moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland where she worked as a nurses aide and a private duty care giver until 1985.

She was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Parish.
