Marion Kotko Kuehnle of Chestertown, Maryland died on November 5, 2009 at Heron Point in Chestertown. She was 90.

She was born in Brooklyn, NY on March 13, 1919 the daughter of Ignats and Anna Savich Kotko. She was a graduate of Ursinus College in Collegeville, Pennsylvania class of 1940. She married Christian Albert Kuehnle in 1944 in Annapolis, MD. Mrs. Kuehnle served in the United States Naval Reserve from December 1942 to November 1944, working as a chemist, and was honorably discharged at the rank of Lieutenant. She resided in Annapolis, MD where she raised her family.

She and her husband resided in Annapolis until moving to Royal Oak, Talbot County, Maryland and in 1992 became a resident at Heron Point in Chestertown, Maryland. Her husband predeceased her in 1995.

She is survived by her children, Jennifer Farrington of Everglades City, FL and Gail Rowley of Willow Springs, MO; grandchildren, Calile Himes of Denver, CO, Athena Iverson of Denver, CO, and Donald Robert Hayes, III of Baltimore, MD; great grandchildren, Alexis, Marina, Garrett, Blythe, and Hale.

A daughter, Christine Hayes predeceased her in 1990.
