



Marion Wilson Massey

Marion Wilson Massey of Easton, died at his home on Saturday, March 23, 2002. He was 83.

Born on November 19, 1918 in Hillsboro, Md. he was the son of late Marion S and Mary Pinder Massey. After graduating from Centreville High School in 1936 he worked for Acme Markets in Lewes De. In 1938 he joined the U.S. Army. During WWII he was part of the Normandy Invasion in Northern France, and was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, American Defense Service Medal, European African Middle Eastern Service Medal, Distinguished Unit and Combat Infantry Badges. After his release from active duty in 1945 he returned to the Eastern Shore. He worked as a typesetter for the Star Democrat in Easton then in 1963 began working for the Daily Times in Salisbury, where he remained until his retirement in 1985 as a supervisor. His first wife the former Armistice Hosking whom he married in 1944 died in 1989. In 1993 he married Doris S. McCarty and they made their home in Easton.

He was a former member of St Albans Episcopal Church of Salisbury and attended St. Marks United Methodist Church of Easton. In addition he was also a member of V.F.W. Post 05118 of Salisbury and B.P.O. Elks Lodge 1622 of Easton.

In addition to his wife Mr. Massey is survived by two sons; David C. Massey

and his wife Pam of Ocean City, Md. and Michael W. Massey of Bethesda, Md. five step-children; Debra Cole, Lynn Crouch, Kim McCarty, Steven McCarty all of Easton and Christie Spurry of St. Michaels, two brothers; Fred Massey of Aberdeen, Md. and Norman Massey of Wye Mills, two grandchildren Jillian Massey of Ocean City and Erin Swanson of Berlin, Md. six step-grandchildren Adam McCarty of Glen Burnie, Md. Trey Ross of Carroll-ton, Tx., Skye Westerfield of Cordova, Md., Michael Crouch of Easton Caitlin Spurry and Julia Spurry both of St. Michaels. one great-grandchild Taylor Swanson. He was predeceased by a brother Kennard Massey and a sister Louise Pacquette.

Funeral services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home Easton, on Tuesday March 26, 2002 at 11:00AM where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
