Marjorie Edrop Morris, born in Brooklyn, New York in 1914 to Edith and Arthur Edrop, died on November 21, 2004 in Lakeville, CT. She was 90.

Married to Robert Cooper Morris in Saint Davids, PA in 1935, she moved to Claylands, Island Creek Neck Trappe, MD, where they spent the rest of their lives in profound contentment. Mr. Morris died in 1984.

Marjorie was a Grey Lady during World War II, and later worked at the Country School as a nursery school teacher, and at her husband's manufacturing business, Metratch/Multifax in Easton. She was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club for many years, where her children sailed. Beyond all she loved gardening and flower arranging, in which she was an artist; and books, reading and writing. She wrote articles for the local papers, illustrated by photographs taken by her grandchildren, Josi and Leif Garbisch. She co-authored a much praised handbook for those serving jury duty, which duty she herself served many times.

Mrs. Morris is survived by three children, Georgine Garbisch, Marjorie White and William Morris; five grandchildren, Josephine Fleishman, Leif Garbisch, Joseph White, Pascal Naqib and Allison Morris; and four great-grandchildren, Amaran, Jirina and Levin Garbisch and Saskia Fleishman.
