



Marjorie Greeley Robb Snow

November 11, 1922 - August 21, 2010

Marjorie Greeley Robb Snow of Annapolis, Maryland, died on August 21, 2010 of complications from a stroke at Ginger Cove Health Center.

The daughter of Marjorie Newell Robb and Floyd Newton Robb, she was born in New Jersey on what was then called Armistice Day, November 11, 1922. In her youth, Marjorie particularly loved spending summers at the family beach home in Sakonnet, Rhode Island. A graduate of New Jersey's Kent Place School and Erskine College, she met and married Navy LCDR Vincent A. Sweeney in 1942. During the war years she remained at home raising her children while Vince was at sea. As a Navy wife, she lived in Annapolis, Maryland, Jacksonville, Florida, Lexington, Massachusetts and on the island of Guam. The family eventually settled in Falls Church, Virginia in the early 1950s. In 1968, Marjorie and Vince parted ways and she moved to New England, first to Lincoln and later to Pepperell, Massachusetts and then to Little Compton, Rhode Island when she married her childhood friend, Willard Clark Snow, in 1972. With Bill Snow, for many years she owned and operated a popular retail clothing store as well as her own interior design business. After Bill's death in 2004, Marjorie moved back to Annapolis, joining the Ginger Cove retirement community where she enjoyed many wonderful friendships, especially her close friend, Clement James.

Marjorie had a lifelong passion for the stage, starring in many summer stock plays as a young woman. Accompanying her two daughters, she was actively involved in horseback riding, she was known for her beautiful needlework and loved raising dogs of all breeds.

She is survived and deeply missed by three children, Gordon C. (Janice) Sweeney of Fayetteville, Arkansas, Mary S. (Michael) Payne of Stevensville, Maryland, and Sandra S. (Arthur) Gallo of Santee, California. Her son, Douglas N. Sweeney died in 1970. She also leaves two granddaughters, Ami Keeler and Angela Bookout, and three great grandchildren, Jacob Bookout, Jessica Bookout, and Emma Sweeney. Her sister, Madeleine Robb Crowley resides in Cupertino, California. Her brother, Arthur Newell Robb and sister, Rosalind Robb Livermore predeceased her, as did her two husbands, Vincent

Sweeney and Wallard Snow.

She will be laid to rest with several family members including her parents and grandparents at the Newell family plot at Mount Auburn Cemetery in Cambridge, Massachusetts, where a private service will be held.
