Marjorie Orgain Fitzgerald of Easton, Maryland, died unexpectedly at her home on May 26, 2004. She lived 91 full and rich years. She was "Mobie" or "Aunt Marj" to all of us who loved and admired her. Mrs. Fitzgerald was born on July 16, 1912 in Jersey City, New Jersey, the daughter of the late Roy and May Coppinger Orgain. She grew up in Mountain Lakes, New Jersey and was graduated from The Wilson School. She was a graduate of Bennett College in Millbrook, New York. In May 1941 she married attorney Thomas Gannon Fitzgerald of Chicago, Illinois. They were married 57 years. He predeceased her in 1998.

Mrs. Fitzgerald was a lifelong Episcopalian and served her church with enthusiasm and creativity. She also collected antique dolls and period costumes, an avocation which grew into the presentation of fashion shows that benefited schools, churches and other community organizations. Marjorie was also a faithful volunteer and window-dresser at her church thrift shops. She and Mr. Fitzgerald were long-term residents of Evanston, Illinois, Stanfordville, New York and Summerville, South Carolina. Her final years were spent in Easton, Maryland, where she was a member of Christ Church.

Mrs. Fitzgerald leaves two nieces, Patricia Orgain Wood of So. Burlington, Vermont and Lisa Orgain Jackson of Weaverville, North Carolina; a nephew, Peter Orgain of So. Strafford, Vermont; and two grand-nephews, Nathan and

David Orgain of Vermont. A brother Robert R. "Pat" Orgain predeceased her.

A memorial service will be held Tuesday, June 8 at Christ Church, So. Harrison St., Easton, Maryland at 11am. Burial will be in the family plot at Greenwood Cemetery in Boonton, New Jersey.
