



## Mark J. Palamaras Sr.

September 19, 1948 - April 8, 2014

Mark James Palamaras of Harmony, MD, died on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, at Talbot Hospice Guest Wing. He was 65.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA, on September 19, 1948, to Viola L. Schmick and the late Nickco L. Palamaras. Mr. Palamaras moved to Cambridge, MD, at an early age with his family. He attended Dorchester County Schools where he excelled in athletics, attained Eagle Scout status, and graduated in 1966. He attended University of Maryland College Park.

He married his beloved wife, Sharon Palamaras on April 2, 1977. Mr. Palamaras began his career at Sears. Following his tenure at Sears he then purchased Home Beautiful in Cambridge, MD. After several years, they moved the business to Easton, MD, expanding to Home Beautiful Carpet One. He was Co-Chairman of the Cambridge Christmas Parade, Past President of Dorchester Chamber of Commerce, past Chairman of Dorchester United Fund, and an active member of Easton Rotary. He retired in 2005 to devote full-time his lifelong passion of antique restorations and custom built furniture.

Mr. Palamaras enjoyed antiquing, sailing, skiing, scuba diving, wood working and enjoying time with his family, friends and most especially, his grandchildren.

In addition to his wife of thirty-seven years, Sharon Palamaras, Mr. Palamaras is survived by his two children, Mark J. Palamaras, Jr. (Kara) of Truckee, CA and Leeanne Young (John) of Cambridge, MD; his mother, Viola L. Schmick and step-father Lawrence Schmick; his sister, AmyBeth Laning (Dave) Raleigh, NC; two grandchildren, Nickco Palamaras, Ian Young; and three step-grandchildren.

A celebration of life will be held on Monday, April 14, 2014, at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, 100 Peachblossom Road, in Easton, beginning at 11 a.m. Interment will be private.
