Mark E. Englebach of Crumpton, MD died Thursday, August 14, 2003 in the Elsmere Veterans Hospital, Elsmere DE. He was 48.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of James Englebach of Marion NC and Elizabeth Chew Dixon of Rehoboth, DE.

He was a 1974 graduate of Kent County High School and later served in the United States Navy for six years during the Vietnam War. He was an independent truck driver.

Mr.Englebach was a Life member of the Vietnam Veterans Motorcycle Club USA, DE Chapter D. and was a Past Commander and Past Kent County Commander of the C. Henry Price II American Legion Post #246, Betterton, MD. He was also a member of the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 83. To his friends and family Mr. Englebach was known as “Knucklehead”. He enjoyed building and repairing motorcycles, but his ultimate joy was riding his Harley. He also loved gardening, playing pool, remodeling his home, and taking walks.

In addition to his parents, Mark is survived by his wife, Cynthia Lee Leager Englebach; three daughters, Cirsten R. Englebach of Salina Kansas, Amber E.Englebach of the United States Navy, and Holly S. Englebach of
