



Marlin Zimmerman, Jr.

August 2, 1923 - May 23, 2010

Marlin U. Zimmerman, Jr., of Easton, MD, died at Genesis Healthcare – The Pines on May 23, 2010. He was 86 years old.

He was born in Akron, OH, on August 2, 1923, the son of the late Marlin U., Sr. and Helen Nelson Zimmerman.

After graduating from Easton High School in 1940, he attended the Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, where he received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemical Engineering in 1944. He later earned his Master of Business Administration Degree from Harvard University in 1966 and was selected as a Baker Scholar.

After graduation from Johns Hopkins, he worked for Standard Oil of Ohio in Cleveland for twenty years. From 1966 to 1969, he was manager of Long Term Planning for the Norton Company in Worcester, MA. After working for three years in New York City for John Van Der Valk and Associates, he became a private consultant for Chungju Fertilizer Company in South Korea, London, and Houston, TX.

A member of the American Institute of Chemical Engineer, he was also a member of the Johns Hopkins Club, Tudor and Stuart Club, Tau Beta Pi, Omicron Delta Kappa, Beta Theta Pi, and St. Marks United Methodist Church

in Easton. His biography is listed in Who's Who in Science and Engineering.

Other achievements include a patent for process improvement of TOSCO shale process for oil recovery and several other patents. His avocations included travel, photography, reading, investing and computer programming.

Mr. Zimmerman is survived by the families of George L. Zimmerman of Bryn Mawr, PA, and Louise Zimmerman Forscher of Exeter, NH, and the family of the late William Price, III.

A memorial service will be held at St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton on Saturday, June 5 at 11:00 a.m. Internment will be at the Gravel Hill Cemetery in Palmyra, PA in the Zimmerman Family Lot.
