Marlyn S. Friedman of Grasonville, MD died at her home on Friday, December 12, 2003. She was 61.

Born on September 17, 1942 in Woodbridge, NJ, she was the daughter of the late Jack and Celia Blum Turner. In 1964 she graduated from Russell Sage College in Troy, NY receiving a Bachelors degree in Mathematics and Education. She then received a Masters Degree in Curriculum & Instruction from Loyola College in 1992.

On January 3, 1981 she married Elliott I. Friedman and they made their home in Olney, MD. It was in 1988 that they moved to the Eastern Shore, residing in Grasonville.

Mrs. Friedman began her teaching career at Woodbridge High School. She later moved to Maryland teaching at High Point High School, Springbrook High School, Jewish Day School, Easton High School, Queen Anne's County High School, Kent Island High School and her most current position was at the Queen Anne's County Alternative School.

Mrs. Friedman was a member of the Mathematics Education Association and Prospect Bay Yacht Club. She enjoyed photography, boating, gardening, and spending time with her family.
