Marsina May Martin Patterson of Chestertown, MD died on June 1, 2007. She was 88 years old. The only child of Margaret Conwell, born in Keyport, NJ on August 5, 1918.

She grew up in Leonardo, NJ and graduated from Leonardo High School in the Class of 1937.

She married Charles R. Patterson, Jr. on July 4, 1940. He died on August 18, 2006 after 66 years of marriage. They moved to Cambridge, MD in 1949 and her present farm near Chestertown, Queen Anne County in 1958.
