September 23, 1922 - September 27, 2010

Martha Brooks Dickerson of Rock Hall, MD, died on Monday, September 27, 2010, at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 88.

Born on September 23, 1922, in Pamaona, MD, she was the daughter of the late, William and Ella White Brooks. She graduated from Rock Hall High School, Class of 1939. Martha went to Baltimore to live with her sister and attended Strayer University Business College. She married Joseph Dickerson on April 7, 1951. They made their home in Baltimore until 1966 when they moved to Connecticut, Moorestown, NJ, and Indianapolis, IN, and returned to Maryland in 1974. He retired, and in 1981, they moved to Fenwick Island, DE, permanently in 1991 and in 2002 to Rock Hall, MD. She worked as a regional statistician with Standard Oil of New Jersey, now called Mobil Oil Company. After that she raised her children and worked as a real estate agent with Russell T. Baker in Severna Park, MD. She was a member of the St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall. Martha enjoyed playing cards with her friends and cooking.

She is preceded in death by her son, Mark Dickerson.

In addition to her husband, Joseph Dickerson, she is survived by her son, Joseph Brooks Dickerson; her daughter, Kathryn Ann Dickerson; and two grandchildren, Leah Asher and Diana Dickerson.

A visitation will be held on Thursday, September 30, 2010, from 6:00 – 8:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Chestertown, MD. Funeral services will be held on Friday, October 1, 2010, at 10:00 AM at St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall, MD. Interment will be held in Wesley Chapel Cemetery in Chestertown, MD.
