April 7, 1922 - July 18, 2008

Martha Elizabeth Bush Schuette of Severna Park, MD, formerly of Easton, MD, died on Friday, July 18, 2008 at Genesis Health Care Severna Park Center, Severna Park, MD. She was 86.

Born on April 7, 1922 in Greenford, Ohio, she was the daughter of the late Dewey and Mary Archer Bush. She first attended Kent State University at Kent, Ohio, then transferred to Wittenberg University, Springfield, OH, in 1944. On June 4, 1944, she married George William Schuette. In 1945, Pastor Schuette was ordained and over the next thirty-seven years she served as his helpmate in serving many Lutheran Churches in Indiana. Mrs. Schuette taught third grade in Indiana for twenty-four years, retiring in 1982 when she and her husband moved to Easton, MD. Rev. Schuette preceded her in death on December 17, 2002.

While residing in Indiana, she served on the Board of the Lutheran Church Women of the Indiana-Kentucky Synod, and as a board member of the Oesterlen's Children's Home in Springfield, OH. In Easton, she was a member of Grace Lutheran Church and the Talbot County Women's Club. She was an avid gardener, quilter, reader, and recently discovered water colors and oil painting.

Mrs. Schuette is survived by two daughters, Rebecca Leah Folkemer of

Gibson Island, MD, and Bonita Elizabeth Best of Warwickshire, Kenilworth England; three brothers, George Bush of Kissimmee, FL, Joseph Bush of Canfield, OH, and Raymond Bush of Fanfield, OH; and five married grandchildren, Laura Empey, Julie Zimmer, Amy Starr, Sarah Jacobs, and Nathaniel Folkemer. She is also survived by a granddaughter, Collette Best of England; one great-granddaughter; and seven great-grandsons. A brother William Bush and a sister Bonita June Bush of Columbia MD, preceded her in death.
