



## Martha B. Marvel

Martha B. Marvel of Easton, MD died on Sunday, October 17, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 87.

Born June 10, 1917 in Denton, MD, she was the sixth child of a large family of the late Wilbert and Hulda Andrews Butler of Tuckahoe Neck, Denton. After graduating from Caroline County High School in 1935, she attended a beautician school in Wilmington, DE. Upon graduation, she worked briefly as a beautician in Wilmington. On September 17, 1939, she married L. Everett Marvel and they made their home in Easton, MD. They operated Marvels grocery store at 615 Goldsborough St. in Easton until Everett accepted employment with the U.S. Postal Service at the Easton Post Office. Martha worked as a W.T.
