Martha Jean Richardson died at her home in Wellington, FL on Saturday, October 5, 2002. She was 77.

Known by her friends as “Marti”, she served for twenty years in the American Foreign Service in Costa Rica, Ecuador, Paraguay, Mexico, Peru, Kenya (for the Bureau of African Affairs), Hong Kong, Spain, Portugal and many other United States Embassy locations throughout the world. After retirement from the Foreign Service, she provided accounting and financial advisory services for small to mid-size businesses in the Washington, D.C. area while residing in Bethesda, Maryland.

During her years in the Potomac area, she developed her love of the equestrian lifestyle, owning several riding horses. In 1991 she moved to Wellington to pursue her interests in croquet, golf, bridge, and show dogs. One of her miniature toy poodles took top honors in all competitions and was named 1991’s top poodle.

Ms Richardson is survived by her sister, Virginia Day of Oxford, MD; a brother, John Richardson of Fripp Island, SC; eleven nieces and nephews and many great-nieces and great-nephews.
