Martin Daniel Heiderman of Wittman, MD and former resident of Kent Island, died Sunday, April 4, 2004 at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 55.

Born on December 14, 1948 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late George Sherlock Heiderman and Pinky Trussel. He grew up in Violetville, MD and attended schools in Baltimore, graduating from Baltimore City High School in 1967. He joined the United States Marine Corp. his senior year. He served fourteen months in Vietnam receiving the Purple Heart with Fox Company 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines. He was honorably discharged in 1970 and enlisted with the National Guard in 1971 with the 70th General Supply Company in Pikesville, MD and was discharged in 1973. He attended Catonsville Community College from 1979 to 1982 studying advertising and design. He worked for the Veteran's Administration in Baltimore City as an adjudicator until retiring in 1983. He was a member of the Grasonville VFW and the Order of the Purple Heart. He enjoyed football, camping, the water and his chocolate lab.

In addition to his wife, Mary Ann Heiderman, who he married December 4, 1970, he is survived by three sons, Daniel Erich Heiderman of Patuxent Naval Base, Adam Brett Heiderman of Wittman, MD and Alex Martin Heiderman of Wittman; one sister, Nancy Margaret Bull of Howard County, MD; one brother, George Edwood Heiderman of Frederick, MD and two granddaughters, April

Marie and Ericha Paige.
