Martin Leo “Marty” Schultz of Newcomb, MD died as a result of a traffic accident on Wednesday, August 30, 2006. He was 44.

Born March 5, 1962 in Easton, MD, he was the son of J. William “Billy” and Sarah Jurceka Schultz of Lewes, DE. He was a graduate of St. Michaels High School and the owner of Schultz Wood Floor, Inc., a family business formerly known as Schultz & Sons Flooring where he began working with his father at the age of 16. He was a former Cub Scout and Boy Scout of America.

Mr. Schultz was the State Director of A.B.A.T.E. of Maryland, working to promote motorcycle safety and awareness, past director of the local chapter of A.B.A.T.E., and a member of the Maryland State Motorcycle Safety Task Force. He has done charity work for people all over the state and devoted an enormous amount of time in helping others, especially those with economic needs. He was devoted to his family, friends and business. His friends looked up to him and thought of him as family.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Schultz is survived by his wife, the former Pamela J. Packer, whom he married in Royal Oak, MD in 1984; two daughters, Carrie L. Schultz of Cordova, MD, and Jamie L. Schultz of Newcomb, MD; and two brothers, John Schultz of Delaware and Tom Schultz of Tanyard, MD.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, September 7, 2006 at 2:00 PM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton, MD, where friends may call from 12:00 noon until 2:00 PM.
