Mary Ann Justis of Stevensville, MD, died Saturday June 1, 2013, surrounded by her family at home. She was 66.

Born on June 27, 1946, in Nassawadox, VA, she was the daughter of the late, Earle Richardson Small and Evelyn Cohee. Mary Ann grew up in Pocomoke City, MD, and was a graduate of Pocomoke High School. She later graduated from Golden Beacon College and after college she worked as a bookkeeper with Chesapeake Plywood Plant in Pocomoke City. On August 25, 1968, she married John O. Justis and they resided in Wallops Island, VA. They also resided in PA, OH, and MD as she raised her family.

In 1980, they moved to Stevensville, MD, where they have resided for the past 33 years. Mary Ann was an active volunteer with Queen Anne's County Schools system and later returned to work as a bookkeeper with the Kent Island Yacht Club for 25 years. She retired in early 2011.
