Mary Jane Cohee died on Sunday, July 13, 2014, at the University of MD Shore Medical Center at Easton. She was 83.

Mary Jane Cohee was born on February 9, 1931, at White Hall Farm in Tunis Mills. She was the daughter of the late Andrew and Grace Shortall. She graduated from Easton High School in 1948 and married John Cohee on November 11, 1950.
