Mary Louise Easson of Centreville, MD, died Friday September 4, 2015, at Corsica Hills Nursing Center in Centreville, MD. She was 85.

Born on January 12, 1930, in Baltimore, MD, to the late Sylvester Pritchard and Alice Wheeler Pritchard. She graduated high school in Baltimore and later received a bachelor's degree from Towson State Teachers College. In 1951, she married Graeme Easson and resided in Baltimore, MD.
