



Mary Crowe Flanagan

May 26, 1945 - January 31, 2017

Mary Crowe Flanagan of Chestertown, MD, died on January 31, 2017, at Christiana Hospital Center. She was 71.

She was born in Wilmington, DE, on May 26, 1945, the daughter of the late George and Elizabeth Porter Crowe. She was a graduate of Plainfield High School in Plainfield, NJ, and was one of five women in her graduating class from the University of Kentucky, earning a Bachelor's of Science degree with a business concentration.

She married James E. "Jim" Flanagan in 1978. Mrs. Flanagan worked as Vice President for several high tech companies in Massachusetts and Seattle. She was instrumental in the design and implementation of diagnostic engineering for Jaguar Automotive.

She retired in 1999 and moved with her husband from Chicago to Chestertown where she was involved with Horizons, serving on the Board of Directors. She also worked as a realtor and later was the manager with Caldwell Banker Realty.

In addition to her husband, she is survived by children, Paige Robison of Atlanta, GA, and Heather Bobbit of Seattle, WA; sisters, Katherine McMillan and Sally Barckett both of Wilmington, DE; along with four grandchildren; and

one great-grandchild.
