Mary Anne Hartman, of Grasonville, MD died at Luminis Health Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD on February 5, 2026. She was 85 years old.

Mary Anne was born in Washington, DC on February 10, 1940, the daughter of Edward J. Gallagly Sr. and Nora Zwillinger. She attended St. Patrick's Academy High School and spent a dedicated career as an Administrative Officer at NASA Goddard Space Flight Center, while her beloved husband, Jerre, built a distinguished career as an aerospace engineer there.

Happily married to Jerre for 65 years, Mary Anne loved life on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. She was a Master Gardener with extensive knowledge of horticulture and gardening practices, and volunteered for many years at Adkins Arboretum outside of Centreville, MD. An amazing cook, especially famous for her holiday crabcakes, she loved good food and good fun – rarely missing an opportunity to entertain family and friends. She enjoyed boating, crab feasts with loved ones, cheering for the Redskins, reading, and gourmet cooking. On Saturday mornings, as an avid Premier League soccer fan, she rarely missed watching her favorite Chelsea FC team play.

Mary Anne's witty sense of humor and bright smile were infectious – and her love for her two grandchildren, Garrett and Lily, was immeasurable.

The family will be having a private remembrance gathering in the Spring, rumored to include a bagpiper, in honor of Mary Anne's great pride in her Scotch-Irish lineage.

Mary Anne was predeceased by her husband, Jerre, and her brother, Edward Gallagly. She is survived by her sister, Elizabeth Gallagly Brack; her daughter, Kristin Hartman-Richey (Tarek Richey, predeceased); her son, Kevin Hartman (Kristin Hagert Hartman); and her grandchildren.
