Mary Ann Ingraham of Easton, MD, died at the age of 88 on April 20, 2014, at the William Hill Manor surrounded by those who cared for and loved her.

Ms. Ingraham was born in Haddonfield, NJ, on September 28, 1925, and grew up in Easton, MD, and graduated from Easton High School. She was a descendent of Colonel Prentiss Ingraham, an Eastern Shore writer who wrote many adventure novels about Buffalo Bill as well as *Land of Legendary Lore*, a history of the Eastern Shore.

Mary Ann was a devoted grandmother, mother and wife, as well as a gifted artist. She lived a full life which included travels that took her to several continents. She was a life-long learner and created beautiful art even through her final months of life. She will be deeply missed by all who knew her.

She is survived by her children, Miriam Merino Stake and her husband James B. Stake of Minneapolis, MN, and Prentiss Ingraham of St. Petersburg, FL; as well as grandchildren, James Stake, Anne Stake, and Mimi Henriquez and her husband Brian Henriquez; a great grandchild, Mia Henriquez; and numerous nephews, and nieces.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Efrain Gualberto Merino, who graduated from the the United States Naval Academy,

and also by her sisters, Miriam Ingraham LeGates and Prentiss Ingraham Morgan.
