Mary Jane Jones of Greensboro, MD, died on Tuesday, November 18, 2008, at Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD. She was 68.

Born June 26, 1940, in Stevensville, MD, she was the daughter of the late Samuel and Elsie Clark Smith. She graduated from Stevensville High School in the Class of 1958. In 1959, she married Joseph Alfred Jones, Sr. of Grasonville, MD. This marriage later ended in divorce. Mrs. Jones worked as a waitress at Holly's Restaurant, Grasonville, MD, and the Grasonville V.F. W. She also attended college at night so she could become a social worker for the State of Maryland. In 2002, she retired after 27 years of service. Mrs. Jones lived in Centreville, MD, until 2000 when she moved to Greensboro, MD.

She was a member of the Price United Methodist Church.
