Mary Elizabeth Lacy of Easton, MD, formerly of Silver Spring, MD, passed away at Easton Memorial Hospital on Sunday, October 19, 2014.

Mary Elizabeth was born on August 15, 1931, and was raised in Cresaptown, MD. She attended and graduated from Alleghany High School and Frostburg State College with a Master's Degree in Elementary Education/Administration.

From 1955 to 1961, she taught elementary education in the territory of Alaska, not yet a state. In 1961, she relocated to Takoma Park, MD, and accepted the first of many teaching and administrative positions with Montgomery County Public Schools. She served as a teacher, resource teacher, principal, and in the area office. After a long and active career with the County, she retired from full-time employment. This was followed by an additional fifteen years of advisory and mentoring positions within the county working to train future school administrators.
